Roll Back Malaria Campaign

The South Atlantic Regional Board and the Regional Convention delegates have issued a challenge to the members of the South Atlantic Region clubs and members that the South Rowan Y Service Club will match up to \$1000 of the total amount given by all the other clubs in our region to the Roll Back Malaria Campaign. This campaign began on October 24 2008 and will end on March 31, 2009 with all donations needing to be turned in by **March 1, 2009** for reporting purposes.

1. This worthy cause will bond our region together to help save lives in tropical Africa where 3,000 children die daily from malaria;
2. This is a one time, short term designated project that is sanctioned by the United Nations;
3. This is an opportunity for our Region to be leaders in the US and to unite in a mission that is difficult to believe is happening;
4. Individuals, church groups, and other organizations can write a check to your club and will be a tax deductible donation. One malaria prevention kit only cost \$7.50;
5. We can educate our YMCA staff, church groups, and our members about this project.
