sale!

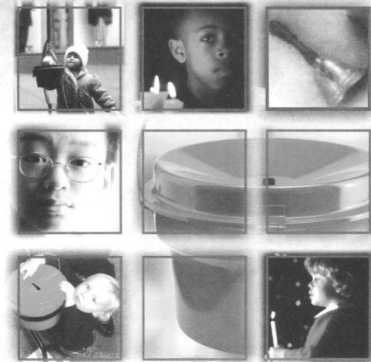
