

MEMBERSHIP/CONSERVATION

When there are a number of new members, or even just one, informal special sessions in a home setting should be considered, with the following possible items to emphasize local club activities.

A group discussion on their interests and concerns and what they feel should be the objective of a service club. Refer to the aims and objectives outlined in the International Constitution.

Members deeply involved in the club can share their experiences (what Y's Men mean to them) and answer questions.

If there is not a particular service project that interests the new members, encourage them to develop their own for presentation to the club. Normally a membership Committee is responsible for arranging the special session.
