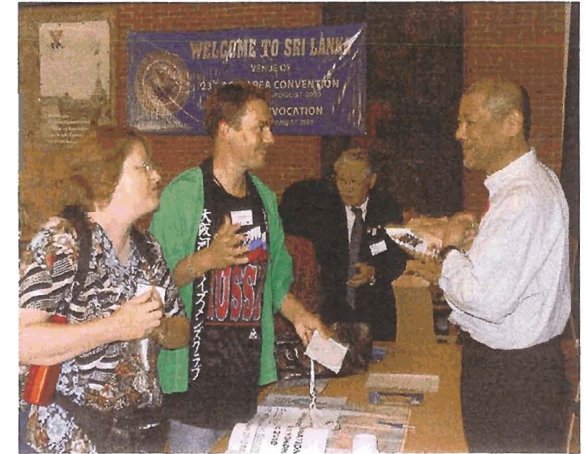
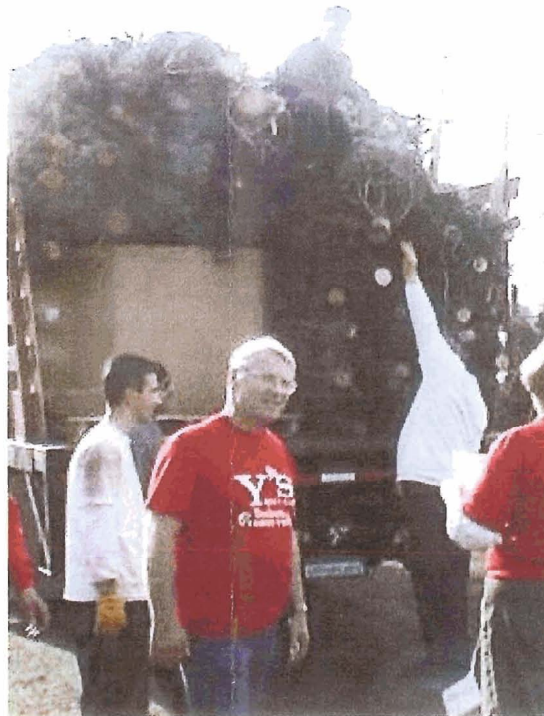
We Are:

- the International Association of Y Service Clubs formally known as Y's Men's Clubs. We are a Worldwide fellowship of persons of all faiths working together in mutual respect and affection, based on the teachings of Jesus Christ. We share a common loyalty to the YMCA, striving through active service to develop, encourage and provide leadership to build a better world for all humanity.
- an organization where the membership is open to people of all faiths and religions and consists of both men and women. No one will be denied membership status because of race, creed, sex, color, religion or national origin. All are eligible to occupy any official post in the organization. Members are grouped into clubs which have connections on a regional, national, and international level.
- the result of actions taken by Judge Paul William Alexander who gathered a group of men for lunch in 1922 for the purpose of being a service club to the local YMCA in Toledo, Ohio (USA).



We Provide Service:

- to the YMCA where clubs work with the YMCA with financial assistance, volunteer activities, and leadership functions.
- to the less fortunate by providing assistance through programs of the YMCA and through community programs. Clubs provide funds for food shelves, Holiday Food Baskets, etc.
- in Youth Development where clubs provide funds for opportunities in Youth in Government, scholarships for youth to go to youth camps, mentoring meetings, Black Achievers groups, local school functions, and other opportunities depending on the local community needs.



We Obtain Personal Service

- by developing leadership skills within the club, the YMCA and local community. Additional leadership opportunities are available within the Y's Men organization at the regional, national and international levels.
- through experiences with other cultures by taking advantage of opportunities to learn and gain additional understanding about persons in their homes and cultures. Members gain new relationships by having communications with clubs and Service Club members in other countries.
- by being a Brotherhood delegate visiting clubs and members in other countries.
- by joining movement-wide global service projects such as our Malaria Project.
