RON ERHARDT, our Edina State Representative, gave a recap of the Transportation Committee's legislative proposal and bills for 2003, 2004 and 2005 legislative session. **RON**, as chairman of the Transportation Committee, also outlined his committee's road and transit funding goals to lower the deficit for Minnesota's transportation needs— i.e. increase gasoline tax by another \$.05 to generate \$320 million per year for the Highway Trust Fund as well as propose a change in the current license fee system to remove the current caps that limit tab fees to \$189 in the second year and \$99 in the third and subsequent years of the life of the vehicle.

RON ERHARDT and the club members had a lively discussion about our clogged metro highways and a need for better design and build procedures to avoid bottlenecks.

BITS AND PIECES:

The second session of the Southdale Y's Men's Club Saturday Y Diner on February 4th served more people so the knowledge that our club is serving food and drink on 'Sports Saturday' is increasing. **JIM HUNTER, JIM LADWIG, and HAROLD WESTERBERG** were the servers.
